

Soon you will be able to travel again – as long as you are healthy and follow the recommendations

Travel is allowed within Sweden from the 13th of June. But the danger of infection is not over yet. You have to follow regulations and be in good health to travel.

People have been behaving according to recommendations during the Corona pandemic. The situation in Sweden has improved accordingly. From the 13th of June, travel is permitted in the whole country. But the pandemic is not over yet, and people can still be infected. Therefore, it is important to continue acting responsibly.

There is a personal responsibility to stick to the advice. If you have any symptoms, even minor ones, that could be Corona virus, travel is *not* allowed.

But also those in charge of camping grounds, public transport or restaurants must adhere to strict regulations. Therefore, the government has delegated to municipalities to control them. County Administrations are helping them.

We continue learning more about the virus, and regulations are adapted to new findings.

We know we need to continue following Corona regulations such as keeping physical distance and avoiding crowded places.

Chose another place if your first choice is too crowded. If there is an increase in infection during summer, regulations may be changed again.

” If you want to travel you really need to think twice”, prime minister Stefan Löfven said in press conference.

More people will be tested.

Now reliable tests are available. Tests showing if you’re infected, as well as tests showing earlier infection. More tests will now be taken to track the disease. In our county, Region Kalmar län is responsible for conducting them.

The precise procedure varies. Those with symptoms will be tested first, and it will be free of charge. The Regions (in charge of hospitals) and the state authorities are presently discussing the procedure. Within a week they shall have come to an agreement.

When the testing increases it may be misinterpreted as an increase in infection, as more infected people with mild symptoms now will be found.
